Circumcised in Christ (2:11):

- “In Him you were also circumcised with the circumcision made without hands”
 - (see Deut. 30:6; Rom. 2:29)
- “ by putting off the body of the sins of the flesh, by the circumcision of Christ”
 - (see Rom. 6:6; Phil. 3:2-3)

Buried with Christ (2:12):

- “buried with Him in baptism”
 - (see Rom. 6:4; 1 Cor. 10:2)
- “in which you also were raised with Him”
 - (see Rom. 6:5)
- “through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead”
 - (see Rom. 6:8-11)

Made Alive with Christ (2:13-14):

- “And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh”
 - (see Eph. 2:1-3)
- “He has made alive together with Him”
 - (see Eph. 2:5)
- “having forgiven you all trespasses”
 - (see Jer. 31:34)

- “having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us”
 - (see Heb. 7:18-19; Rom. 8:3)
- “And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.”
 - (see Eph. 2:14-16; Rom. 7:4)

Spiritual Victory in Christ (2:15):

- “Having disarmed principalities and powers”
 - (see Gen. 3:15; Heb. 2:14)
- “He made a public spectacle of them”
 - (see John 12:31)
- “triumphing over them in it”
 - (see 1 Cor. 15:57)
