- “to which also you were called in one body;”
 - (see Eph. 4:4)
- “and be thankful.”
 - (see Col. 1:3, 12; 2:7; 3:17d; 4:2)

The Word of Christ (3:16):

- “Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly”
 - (see John 15:7; 1 John 2:24; Acts 2:42a)
- “in all wisdom,”
 - (see Col. 1:28; 2 Tim. 2:15)
- “teaching and admonishing one another”
 - (see 1 Thess. 5:11)
- “in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs,”
 - (see Eph. 5:19)
- “singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.”
 - (see Psa. 28:7)

The Name of the Lord (3:17):

- “And whatever you do in word or deed,”
 - (see 1 Cor. 10:31; 1 Pet. 4:11)

- “do all in the name of the Lord Jesus,”
 - (see Eph. 5:20)

- “giving thanks to God the Father”
 - (see 1 Thess. 5:18)

- “through Him.”
 - (see Heb. 13:15; Phil. 1:11)
